To assist foreign visitors in obtaining visas for attending the ASMBS 39th annual meeting, The American Society for Metabolic and Bariatric Surgery (ASMBS) is in the process of registering this conference with the Department of State. Please submit a copy of this letter, along with copies of your meeting registration and hotel reservation confirmation to help speed up the visa application and approval process.

Travel visa applicants are encouraged to apply as early as possible. The Department of State recommends applying at least 3 months before the meeting. Some consulates may have backlogs in scheduling visa interviews, so applicants should first contact the consulate to find out how long the wait is for an interview.

In addition to obtaining travel visas, all foreign attendees are fully responsible for the costs of meeting registration, travel, lodging, and related expenses associated with attending this meeting.
